

ORDINANCE

TOWN OF MOULTONBOROUGH, NEW HAMPSHIRE

An Ordinance Relative to the Feeding of Ducks and Wild Animals

- Section 6.1 This ordinance is adopted and promulgated per RSA 31:39 for the protection of the health of the inhabitants and the purity of public waters, beaches and public areas in the Town of Moultonborough, such action being taken pursuant to powers vested in the Town.
- a. No person or persons shall feed ducks or wild animals on Town property.
 - b. Any law enforcement personnel or designated town employee may issue a notice of violation.
 - c. Such notice shall impose upon the cited person a forfeiture of ten dollars (\$10.00), which must be paid at the Town Clerk's Office within ten (10) days of the date and time notice is given.
 - d. In the event such penalty is not paid to the Town within the time limitations specified, a summons shall be issued for appearance in district court and any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and could be fined up to two-hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).

This ordinance shall become effective this 1st day of August, 1991.
