

ORDINANCE #3

TOWN OF MOULTONBOROUGH, NEW HAMPSHIRE

An Ordinance Relative to All Pets Control Regulation

The following regulations are enacted for the general welfare and protection of the Public within the Town of Moultonborough and become effective as provided for in New Hampshire RSA 47:17 sec. XI.

- Section 3.1 No pets will be allowed on the Moultonborough Town Beaches, to-wit, Long Island Beach and States Landing Beach, during the period extending from Memorial Day to Labor Day each year.
- Section 3.2 The penalty for this offense shall be the same as provided for in RSA 466:31-II: specifically, the offense shall consider the pet to be a nuisance or menace: thereby providing for a civil forfeiture of fifty dollars (\$50.00) or otherwise disposed of in the District Court for Southern Carroll County in Ossipee, New Hampshire.
- Section 3.3 The provisions of this ordinance are subject to the severability clause and the invalidation of one portion shall not affect any other portion.
- Section 3.4 All fines of forfeiture collected under the provisions of these regulations shall incur to the General Funds of the Town of Moultonborough.

This Ordinance is effective immediately and supersedes all previous ordinances. Approved and enacted on April 8, 1982.
