Seasonal Laborers: Support operations of Public Works Department by maintaining cemeteries, building grounds and assisting road crews as required. Knowledge of maintenance practices, ability to use hand held/operated equipment such as mowers, powers brooms, leaf blowers, and minor mechanical ability helpful. 30+/- hrs per week. Some positions are 8+/- weeks while others may be 12+/- weeks. Valid driver's license, High School Diploma or GED required. **Use form entitled Town Standard Application.**

Seasonal Recreation Staff: Lifeguards, Water Safety Instructors, Tennis Instructor and Day Camp Counselors, and CITs (25+/- hrs per week for 8+/- weeks with some positions being 35+/- hrs per week over a 10 week commitment). Lifeguards and water safety instructors must have current Red Cross Certifications. Experience working with children helpful. Minimum age 16. Volunteer Counselor- In-Training minimum age 15. **Use form entitled Town Recreation Application.**

Construction Manager: Represent Town, under general direction of Town Engineer, on construction sites inspecting excavations, backfill and compaction, grading, paving, and the like. Extensive knowledge of site, roadway, drainage, and recreation field construction required. Civil Engineering background helpful. 25+/- hrs per week for 8+/- weeks. **Use form entitled Town Standard Application.**
