### **Moultonborough Recognizes 2009 Adopt A Spot Participants**

At its meeting of September 17<sup>th</sup>, the Moultonborough Board of Selectmen heaped praise upon the participants in the Town's program to beautify prominent public locations by having them adopted by local businesses and individuals. Seven businesses or service clubs and two families adopted 9 spots throughout the community ranging from the Town entry sign at Center Harbor to the larger scale Sutherland Park.

All were given certificates of appreciation and the top three spots were given special plaques of recognition, after a judging by local gardeners. A First Place went to Donnybrook Services for their work at the Community Center (Recreation), Second Place went to Pine Ridge Landscaping for their work in the Front of Town Hall and Third Place went to Miracle Farms Landscaping for the entry sign at the Center Harbor Town line.

Other participants included Al Hume at the Holland Street Transfer Station, James & Karen Nizus & Family at Playground Drive, Dion's Plant Place at the North Parking Island of Town Hall, Lighthouse Contracting Group at the South Parking Island of Town Hall and the Moultonborough Lion's Club & Aubuchon Hardware at Sutherland Park.
