Moultonborough Seeks Public Input Regarding Next Chief of Police

The Town of Moultonborough is asking the community to weigh in on the upcoming search for the next Chief of Police. The method for community involvement will be an online survey available on the Town's Web site of www.moultonboroughnh.gov. [Click here to take survey.](#)

The survey contains a number of fixed and open ended questions aimed at identifying the ideal characteristics they think are needed in the next Chief of Police and the issues the Chief will face when they arrive at their new job. There are also questions aimed at identifying issues of concern and what steps the next chief can take to improve the effectiveness of the department to meet the community's needs.

This community input will help the Town shape a Profile and Challenge Statement that will be used in the upcoming recruitment process to identify the chief that will be the best fit for Moultonborough.

Chairman of the Board of Selectmen Joel Mudgett said, "Public support for the police department is essential and the face of the department to the community is the Chief. The Town wants to hear from the people of Moultonborough what is important to them as we go forward with hiring a new Chief of Police. We hope folks will make it a priority to take the 10 minutes that is needed to complete the survey and assist us in this most important matter."

The survey is anonymous and will remain open until October 13, 2011.
